

TT Road Races 2016



ROADS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC

Notice is given that The Tourist Trophy Road Races Order 2016 will permit the Promoters to hold practices, races and parades during the TT Festival period. If weather or other circumstances require races, practices or parades to be delayed or postponed then crossing points may be open under the control of Marshals at such times as the Clerk of the Course may specify.

1. ONE WAY ON THE A18 MOUNTAIN ROAD

The A18 Mountain Road will be closed from Barrule Park, Ramsey to Creg-ny-Baa between 9.30 am and 4.30 pm on Friday 27 May 2016 and will then re-open to ONE WAY traffic from the Ramsey Hairpin to the Creg ny Baa for the whole TT period until 9.30 am on Monday 13 June 2016.

Caution - Sat Nav users should be aware that the Road Closures and One way system over the Mountain are not picked up by Sav Nav devices so always obey the signs.

2. ROADS CLOSED

The main roads known as the TT COURSE will be CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC for the 2016 TT Practices, Parades and Races as follows -

3. DELAYED AND POSTPONED RACES

In the event of adverse weather conditions etc the start of any race, including a Parade, may be delayed.

ROADS OPEN not later than 9.30pm except the Mountain Road which will open not later than 10.30pm.

4. Notification of delayed and postponed closures will be given in the news bulletins on local radio.

5. CROSSING PLACES AND ACCESS CORRIDORS

In any interval, the Clerk of the Course may authorise traffic to cross or proceed along the Course at the places specified below, at such times as they may specify:-

- Douglas, St Ninians crossroads between Ballaquayle Road and Ballanard Road
- Douglas, Bottom of Bray Hill between Stoney Road and Tromode Road
- Douglas, Peel Road between the Quarterbridge and Strang Road, Union Mills
- Crosby, between Old Church Road, Eyreton Road and Ballavitchel Road
- Michael, Barregarrow crossroads
- Kirk Michael, between Douglas Road Corner and Station Road and

- Glen Road at Ballaugh Bridge
- Lezayre, Sulby Glen crossroads
 Ramsey, between Glen Auldyn and Gardeners Lane
- Ramsey, between Christian Street and Westbourne Road
- Ramsey, between Lheaney Road and Barrule Park
- Onchan, between Signpost Corner and Bedstead Corner
- Onchan and Douglas, between Governor's Road, Victoria Road and Second Avenue

6. ACCESS ROAD TO THE INSIDE OF THE TT COURSE

Restricted vehicular access to the inside of the Course, including Noble's Hospital, for cars and small vans below 3,500kg, is via the A5 New Castletown Road near the junction with the Quarterbridge Roundabout. The Access Road is narrow with passing places and traffic is controlled. No pedestrian access is permitted.

7. ROADS OPEN

The TT Course will be re-opened for traffic by an official motor vehicle displaying a notice "Roads Open" proceeding along the Course upon the completion of the Practices and Races, and by the passing of such vehicle the part of the Course so passed is open for traffic. For the Mountain Road the official motor vehicle will display "Roads Open One Way".

8. DO NOT ENTER A CLOSED ROAD

It is an offence to enter or remain on a road that has been closed. It is also an offence to enter or remain in a **Prohibited and Restricted Area** during road closure periods. Please respect the Marshals' advice - they are trying to keep you
